SO WE ARE DISCIPLES

Rice Haggard (1769-1819) & O'Kelly 1794 formerly developed a set of guiding tenets (principles) of the Christian Church.

In Virginia

The "Cardinal Principles of the Christian Church"

1. The Lord Jesus Christ is the only Head of the Church.
2. The name Christian to the exclusion of all party and sectarian names.
3. The Holy Bible our only creed, and a sufficient rule of faith and purpose.
4. Christian character, the only test of Church fellowship and membership.
5. The right of private judgement and the liberty of conscience, the privilege and duty of all.
6. The union of all Christians to the end that the world may believe.

These principles predated the Stone-Campbell movement by a decade. The Cane Ridge communion dated August 6 – 11 1801 was attended by some 20,000 people of various faiths: Christian, Presbyterian, Methodist, Baptist. The Union of Disciples and Christians occurred in 1832. (cont. next column)

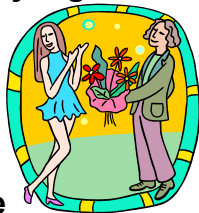
